ELIGIBILITY

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

- 1. OBSERVE DEADLINES. Remember that the application must be **postmarked** by the May 6, 2022 deadline. Any application not postmarked or delivered by hand to the NYTB office by this date will be **disqualified**.
- 2. Do not use application forms from previous years. **Only the 2022 Application Form will be accepted.** No others will be considered for selection.
- 3. Application Form, essays and Letters of Recommendation must be typed. *Hand-written Application Forms, essays and Letters of Recommendation will not be considered.*

- 4. Type all material in no smaller than a 12-point font size.
- 5. Complete all sections of the application form and include all appropriate and relevant information.
- 6. Clearly identify your rationale for selection of the undergraduate or graduate program you have chosen and give attention to your personal statement.
- 7. Exercise care in selecting the persons who will supply letters of recommendation. Be sure to stress to them that letters must be typed.
- 8. PROOFREAD your application.
- 9. Read and sign the *Verification Statement* on page 6. This indicates that should you be selected to receive a NYTB scholarship you understand and accept the responsibilities, obligations, conditions, and possible causes of revocation of the award.
- 10. Maintain a copy of your application for your records.
- 11. **ASSEMBLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER**: Application Form, two Letters of Recommendation (sealed), and Transcript(s) (sealed).

Recipients of New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. Scholarships will be required:

- To provide a recent original color photograph and a brief biographical sketch for publicity purposes.
- To pursue the proposed course of study at the institutions listed, unless prior approval of changes in plans is secured from the NYTB.
- To pursue study as a full-time student and to maintain a high level of scholarship and good academic standing.
- To immediately notify the NYTB of any circumstances that may significantly alter student status.
- Student **must** be able to be present on 2022 Day at Saratoga Race Course to receive scholarship.
