# Following the 'Stars'

**WE ARE APPROACHING** the climax of the racing year, which culminates locally with Empire Showcase Day Oct. 22 and, nationally, on the first weekend in November with the Breeders' Cup World Championships races at Santa Anita. With this in mind I have been thinking about several of our younger New York-breds who could become stars of tomorrow.

As you probably know, *Thoroughbred Daily News* has a signature feature called "Rising Stars." The worldwide staff of the online daily publication use the designation to flag horses who in their first few starts appear to show the promise of going on to become graded stakes winners.

The current listing of "Rising Stars," on the *TDN* website, which extends back to New Year's Day 2013, features such luminaries as Eclipse champion Honor Code, multiple grade I winner Wedding Toast, and the wonderful, incomparable, and undefeated 3-year-old Songbird. To be sure, many of *TDN*'s "Rising Stars" have not gone on to fulfill their potential, but, at the least, the designation signals a young horse whose early achievements are worthy of national attention.

In 2013, 2014, and 2015, "Rising Star" status rarely came to New York-breds. In 2013 Maximova (by Danehill Dancer) made the grade after winning her first two starts routing on the turf in open company. It should be noted, however, that although foaled in New York, Maximova did not meet the eligibility requirements to become a registered New York-bred. In 2014 Wonder Gal (by Tiz Wonderful) earned her "Star" after a blowout debut victory in the Lynbrook Stakes for New Yorkbreds. Then, in 2015, New York-bred, New York-sired She's All Ready (by Girolamo) made the grade after her eye-catching Saratoga debut.

It took three years to collect these three New Yorkbred "Rising Stars." The next three followed in only three months.

On July 9 of this year Louis Lazzinnaro's homebred juvenile Bobby On Fleek earned a "Rising Star." Debuting on what would have been the 75th birthday of the late Bobby Frankel, for whom he was named, and trained by Frankel's most successful protégé Chad Brown, the New York-sired Frost Giant colt aced his debut, airing by six lengths after getting six furlongs in 1:10.78.

On Aug. 26 in the Funny Cide Stakes, Bobby On Fleek was soundly beaten by New York's next "Rising Star," Syndergaard. Named for New York Mets' All-Star pitcher Noah Syndergaard and trained by Todd Pletcher for Eric Fein et al., the Majesticperfection colt demolished the field at 3-2 with a stunning 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-length victory, going 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> furlongs in 1:16.75. The colt is being pointed to the one-mile Champagne Stakes (gr. I) Oct. 8. Bred by Burleson Farms and selling for \$92,000 at the 2015 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July yearling sale, Syndergaard then commanded the top New York-bred selling price at this year's Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s April sale, where he brought \$450,000.

Completing the trio of this summer's New York-bred "Rising Stars" is Diversify, a 3-year-old gelding by Bellamy Road bred by Fred W. Hertrich III and John D. Fielding. Trained by Rick Violette Jr., Diversify drove his record to a perfect two-for-two Sept. 22 with a 5½-length state-bred allowance victory for WinStar Farm. Both career starts have earned Beyer Speed Figures of 90. Diversify is a graduate of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga New York-bred preferred yearling sale, where he fetched \$150,000.

So what, if anything, does this sudden proliferation of New York-bred "Rising Stars" mean?

At its basic level the designation bespeaks the quality and promise of the three individuals involved. Kudos to the breeders.

A second point seems more interesting. The stated *"TDN* Rising Star" criteria include, "the quality of the field, margin and time of victory, pedigree, sales price." Syndergaard and Diversify earned their "Stars" in fields of New York-breds. Such "restricted" company was therefore deemed competitive enough to make the winner's victory worthy of national notice. This fact speaks worlds.

In recent years the overall strength of the New York breeding program has earned respect in virtually all quarters: racetrack, sales, and media. These three "Stars" of the summer are not only cause for congratulating three groups of New York breeders, but for congratulating all New York breeders who have contributed to the collective success and national recognition of the program as a whole.

## WAR DANCER TO STAND AT ROCKRIDGE



War Dancer will be first son of War Front to stand in New York

Diamond M Stable has announced that its War Dancer, a multiple graded stakes-winning son of War Front, will be retired at the end of the 2016 racing season and will take up stud duties at Lere Visagie's Rockridge Stud near Hudson.

Bred in Kentucky by Cherry Valley Farm and Stuart Janney III, War Dancer began his racing career for Magdalena Racing and trainer Ken McPeek. He now races for Diamond M Stable and Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott. He has six wins from 29 starts and has earned \$1,066,925, including a win Sept. 10 in Parx' PTHA President's Cup Stakes. He has placed in eight other stakes, including a runner-up effort last year in Belmont Park's Man o' War Stakes (gr. IT).

Out of Deed I Do, by Alydeed, War Dancer will be the first son of top stallion War Front to stand in the Empire State. A stud fee will be announced at a later date.

## DESERT PARTY SOLD; TO STAND AT IRISH HILL CENTURY FARM

New York sire and graded stakes winner Desert Party has been sold by Darley to a partnership that includes the stallion's co-breeder Stephen Sinatra and will be relocated to Irish Hill Century Farm near Saratoga Springs.

"You never know in this business how things are going to work out, do you?" said Sinatra, the managing partner of the stallion's new ownership group. "Having been one of his breeders, I've followed his career closely and am truly excited about being able to stand him and keep him in New York. And I must express my appreciation to Darley for working with us, as I know other offers were also fielded."

Desert Party's 2017 stud fee will be announced in the near future.

A 10-year-old son of Street Cry, Desert Party previously stood at Sequel Stallions in New York for three seasons and was New

York's leading freshman sire of 2014. His first crop included seven stakes horses, among them grade III winner Salama, stakes winner Heart's Song, and grade III-placed Desert Dynamo and Can't Happen Here.

From 60 lifetime winners to date, Desert Party's other top runners are stakes winners Mecke's Madalyn (bred by Sinatra and Corby Caiazzo) and Party Pooper.

Desert Party ranks among the top 10 leading New York sires in 2016, led by Saharan, a Paul Tackett homebred (bred in partnership with Philip Tackett) who is two for three on the dirt and has a career high 102 Equibase Speed Figure.

For the third year in a row, Langpap Stables homebred Fox Rules got his picture taken following Finger Lakes' Sept. 19 Genesee Valley Breeders' Stakes. The 7-year-old son of Roman Ruler held off Empire Dreams in the 11/16-mile race to win by a nose in 1:45.02.

A winner of 12 of 15 starts at the Farm-

ington oval, topped by the 2012 New York Derby and three editions of the Genesee Valley Breeders' Stakes, Fox Rules has 15 wins, four seconds, and two thirds from 42 starts. Fox Rules also finished second to Talk Therapy in the 2013 running of the Genesee Valley. He has earned \$484,101.

### New York-Breds Keep Pace at Keeneland September

from last year. Keeneland's September signed by Woods Edge. She commanded vearling sale was deemed a success by buyers and sellers alike, as the final numbers looked better than the ones from the end-of-season 2-year-old sales and earlier vearling auctions in 2016.

In all, 2,792 yearlings were sold by Keeneland, the vast majority of which were local Kentucky-bred products. The buzzwords of "selectivity" and "quality" rang throughout the sale, as they have at every other Thoroughbred sale for the last two years as the chasm between the best-perceived horses and the rest of the lot continues to deepen.

For the 13-session sale, 86 New Yorkbreds were offered, with 52 selling for \$2.356.500, good for an average of \$45.317. The 34 that went unsold made for an RNA rate of 39.5%. The caveat for the figures, of course, is just the month before at Saratoga 177 state-bred yearlings sold during Fasig-Tipton's preferred sale of New York-breds for an average of \$77.246. Another four of New York's finest sold during Fasig-Tipton's select yearling sale.

Topping the state-breds at the September sale was Hip 940, an Uncle Mo colt purchased by Al and Sandee Kirkwood during the fourth session-and first of Book 2-from the consignment of Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm, agent, for \$325,000.

A Feb. 2 foal bred by Michael J. and Patricia Palenscar, the dark bay or brown colt is out of stakes-placed My Dear Annie, the Palenscars' New York-bred mare by Smart Strike. The yearling was foaled and raised at Tom and Mia Gallo's Blue Stone Farm in Cambridge where the Palenscars have been clients for more than 25 years.

My Dear Annie has had only one starter to date, who is placed. Currently she has a weanling filly by Orb and was bred to Bodemeister for 2017.

The couple also bred the yearling's second dam, the unraced Fancy Landing (by Formal Gold).

The top-priced New York-bred filly also changed hands during the fourth session. Hip 949, a daughter of Tale of the Cat bred by James Lamonica, Lee Sacks, and Soave Stables sold for \$230,000 to



As supplied to Blood-Horse by The Jockey Club Information Systems Inc., include adjusted money from Japan, Hong Kong, and Singapore. Adjusted earnings are put on par with average North American earnings from the previous year. For example, the average North American purse in 2015 is \$21,782, or 50% of the 2015 average purse in Japan. To put earnings on par, all Japanese progeny earnings are multiplied by 50% before being credited to a sire's progeny earnings. Hong Kong earnings are adjusted by 17%; Singapore by 57%. 

# Fall Forward

THE FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA FALL SALE rolls into its fifth year Oct. 17 at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion with a catalog of 319 weanlings, yearlings, broodmares, and broodmare prospects. A larger catalog the last two years perhaps was the reason for slight drops in average and median, but this year's group is a little tighter and the breeding industry continues to gain interest from not only New Yorkers, but from national players.

### Buyers for the Fasig-Tipton fall sale figure to follow the top lots


"The catalog is slightly smaller than last year," said Boyd Browning, president and CEO of Fasig-Tipton. "There are a few less yearlings this year than we had last year, but overall a pretty similar catalog. I believe it's a little more in line in terms of commercial viability.

"There is a very positive mood in New York right now," Browning continued. "The weanling aspect of the Saratoga fall mixed sale has proven to be popular in recent years, and I would expect it to be popular again in 2016. There is a nice group of foals cataloged and there always seems to be a tremendous amount of interest especially in New York for the foals. That trend should continue on into this year."

A strong current in the weanling arena is the weanling-toyearling pinhook market, and this sale has become a steady

springboard to the following summer's preferred yearling sale that takes place during the race meet at Saratoga. Last year's top-priced weanling, a colt by first-crop sire Shanghai Bobby out of the Cure the Blues mare Electric Shock, was pinhooked for \$140,000 at the fall sale by Hunter Valley Farm. The youngster was sold to Jim Moloney for \$200,000 at the New York-bred sale in August. The second-highest priced colt, by Curlin-Blue Catillac, by Bluegrass Cat, was a \$120,000 fall sale buy by Baccari Bloodstock. He was pinhooked to Fasig-Tipton's select yearling sale but was an RNA at \$235,000.

"Anytime you sell 150 weanlings you're going to have folks that have some success," Browning said. "That tends to encourage them and others who observe their behavior to follow in their footsteps. I think there will be a strong buying group participating in 2016."

The broodmare market, according to Browning, is "hard to compare from year to year, but there are some quality mares and quality broodmare prospects in the sale."

Last year's top-priced broodmare, the 7-year-old Justenufappeal, was in foal to Mission Impazible, the state's leading first-crop sire of 2016.

Of note, as the RNA rate has soared the past two years at the fall sale, the RNA rate for broodmares and broodmare prospects has fallen. Last year's rate was 21.6% compared to 48.9% during the sale's inaugural offering in 2012 and 26.6% the next year.

However, the Thoroughbred marketplace has been diverse to say the least in 2016. There seems to be plenty of money for the top lots, but others are a tough sell. Expect no different during this sale.

"I think we'll see the same trends in Saratoga that we've seen everywhere in that the market is gravitating toward what they perceive to be the better quality offerings, particularly on the mare side of things," Browning said. 🕅



Jockey Dylan Davis wins both Lady Finger and Aspirant stakes at **Finger Lakes**  GROWING UP IN SARATOGA SPRINGS, Dylan Davis wasn't much interested in riding the horses that had made his father Robbie a household name in Thoroughbred racing. He preferred dirt bikes, and while the elder Davis hadn't pushed Dylan into riding races, he was none too thrilled with the alternative his son had picked.

"There was one day when I'd gotten too big to ride the dirt bike I had," Dylan



recalled recently. "I asked my father for another one, and he said 'no.' "

The reason?

"He said it was too dangerous," said Dylan. "He'd gotten in a spill on his own dirt bike, and he didn't want me to ride anymore."

In his mid-teens at that point, Dylan had, he said, to "figure out something else to do," so he went back to the horses that he'd learned to ride as a child. It is perhaps only in a jockey's family that becoming a Thoroughbred rider could be considered a safer occupation than riding dirt bikes.


"There are no jumps," Davis offered with a laugh.

A partner in the filly, Robbie Davis purchased Ribbonite with Paddock Proud for \$25,000 earlier this year at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s April sale of 2-year-olds in training. By Griffinite out of the Western Expression mare Western Lariat, Ribbonite was bred in New York by Dr. Bernardo Mongil's Monhill Farm and sold as a yearling for \$2,300 to Rick Lopez at the OBS January mixed sale in 2015.

A maiden that finished second in her debut at Saratoga, Ribbonite was making her third start in the six-furlong Lady Finger. Sent to the front by Davis, she ran the first quarter in :22.41 and cruised to a 6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-length win with both of the jockey's parents on hand to get their picture taken.

"She's a speedy filly and that helps with the track at Finger Lakes," said Dylan. "My family works very hard in the barn, and they really deserved this. To be with my family and win for them means a lot to me."

Two of Dylan's siblings, Jackie and Katie, have also become jockeys, so earlier this year, Dylan staked a claim, sending his father to OBS with strict instructions.

"I told him, 'Find me a 2-year-old,'

" said Dylan. "A New Yorkbred dirt horse with pedigree—he's got a lot of grass horses, so I wanted him to find one he could make some money with in the winter.

"He came back and said, 'I got you one.' "

"She was very correct, very well-balanced," said Robbie. "She looked like her mindset was really there. Her demeanor was really good. I was looking for a sprinter to run year-round in New York, a 2-year-old that was a little precocious and that might be under the radar. I guess we're not under the radar anymore."

Earlier this year, Dylan Davis started stopping by trainer Ken McPeek's Belmont barn on his morning rounds, talking to assistant Jeff Odintz, who, said Davis, had just received a shipment of 2-year-olds and needed some help.

"It must have been the right place at the right time," said Davis. "I started

working a lot of the babies to get ready for the summer, and I found myself in a good spot."

In the \$120,950 Aspirant Stakes, that good spot was on Pat On the Back, a \$70,000 yearling purchase at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale of preferred New York-breds in 2015. Selected by McPeek, the Congrats colt is owned in partnership by Harold Lerner, AWC Stables, Scott Akman, and Nehoc Stables.

Cutting back from seven furlongs to six, Pat On the Back raced well back of the leaders, saving ground inside and coming up the rail to get up and win by a nose.

"I watched the replay 20 times, and I still can't believe we won," said Lerner.

Out of the Awesome Again mare Accomplished, Pat On the Back was bred by Sugar Maple Farm and ran in the Aspirant on 12 days' rest, a decision about which Lerner was initially skeptical.

"I didn't want to ruin the horse by coming back too soon," he said. "Ken said there was \$125,000 on the table if we wanted to take a shot."

The Aspirant win pushed the chestnut colt's earnings to more than \$120.000.

"I'm all for the New Yorkbred program," said Lerner. "It gives you more options for your horse, and the program has really been upgraded. And the prices have gone up: I used to be able to buy for \$30,000 or \$40,000, and now it's \$100,000, \$150,000, \$200,000."

Davis is in good position as he looks ahead to New York Showcase Day Oct. 22 at Belmont Park, when both of these horses might run next.

"It was big for me to win both stakes," said the 21-year-old rider. "A lot of people took notice back at Belmont. I've got new business coming up for Belmont and hopefully through to Aqueduct. New doors are opening up, and new opportunities with some more horses."

# Up and Away

THE SUMMER OF 2016 marked the coming-out party for breeders Andy and Susan Beadnell, who announced themselves as influential stakeholders in the New York-bred marketplace after scoring home runs with two horses.

The Beadnells celebrated their first graded stakes victory as breeders with Haveyougoneaway, the winner of Saratoga's Honorable Miss Handicap (gr. II) July 27 and the Spa's Ballerina Stakes (gr. I) Aug. 27. With the last win, the 5-year-old boosted her career earnings to \$897,425 and stamped herself as a serious contender for the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (gr. I) at Santa Anita Nov. 5. Thirteen days before the Ballerina the Beadnells sold an Uncle Mo colt by the name of Mo Diddley, who was produced by one of their mares, Miss Bodine, for \$450,000 at Fasig-Tipton's New York-bred preferred yearling sale. The sale-topper, consigned by McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds, is the highest-priced horse ever sold at that auction.

The Beadnells, New York natives, are relative newcomers to racing, and only began breeding Thoroughbreds a decade ago. Despite their spectacular back-to-back successes this past summer, the married couple of 49 years are keeping their feet firmly planted on the ground.

"That is one thing about the Thoroughbred business, for every (horse) that makes some money, there are two who don't," Andy Beadnell said in a recent interview.

The Beadnells, both 71, began dating in high school. One of their first endeavors together on the equine front was to buy Ridin-Hy, a dude ranch in the bucolic Adirondack region of New York State. They bred and raised the majority of the Quarter Horses at the resort. Recently, after 45 years at the helm of Ridin-Hy, the Beadnells turned over the reins to two of their sons, Tim and Troy.

But a full retirement from the equine business was out of the question. Their col-

lective attention is now focused on their 100-acre Bead Land & Cattle Company near Pottersville, where both Haveyougoneaway and Mo Diddley were born.

Haveyougoneaway is a daughter of Congrats, produced by One Wise Cowgirl, a mare the Beadnells bred and sold as a 2-year-old to Jack Knowlton. Serendipitous circumstances led One Wise Cowgirl back to the Beadnells.

"She bowed and didn't get to race, and I bought her back, and Susan and I turned her into a broodmare," Beadnell said.

And there begins the winding and extraordinary tale behind the multiple graded stakes-winning Haveyougoneaway, who is currently owned by Sequel Racing and Gary Barber and trained by Tom Morley.

Haveyougoneaway is One Wise Cowgirl's second foal, and was sold by the Beadnells as a weanling for \$50,000 at Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky November sale. Consigned by McMahon of Saratoga Thoroughbreds, Haveyougoneaway was acquired by John Greathouse Bloodstock. Haveyougoneaway went through the ring the following year at Fasig-Tipton's New York-bred preferred sale in Saratoga and was purchased for \$105,000 by Tayloe and Greathouse. She was consigned again, this time as a 2-year-old by the Greathouse family, but failed to reach her reserve at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s horses of racing age sale in June 2013. Still unraced that November, Haveyougoneaway resurfaced in another auction ring, as part of a Greathouse dispersal at Keeneland. She sold for a paltry \$1,200 to Champion Racing Stable, for whom she became a stakes winner at both Oaklawn Park and Remington Park.

Beadnell explained he had reached out to Champion Racing Stable soon after Haveyougoneaway broke her maiden at Oaklawn Park in April 2014 to see if her owners would consider campaigning her in New York, where the Beadnells would stand to earn breeders' awards with the horse.

"Her owners said, 'Why don't you buy half-interest in her and run her there in the summer, and we will run her here in the winter,' " Beadnell recalled. "But

I'm not really in the race business, so I declined. I guess I missed a good opportunity there."

But that wasn't the end of it.

Earlier this year Becky Thomas of Sequel Racing was tipped by a friend about the New York-bred, who had strung together an impressive record at Southwest tracks. Thomas assembled a few investors to purchase Haveyougoneaway privately and brought her back to New York this past spring, with the idea of reselling her at some point as a broodmare prospect.

When the Beadnells found out from Thomas that the stakes-winning mare they bred was returning to New York, they were thrilled. Excitement soon turned into unbridled joy, when the mare promptly won three races in a row—Belmont Park's Dancin Renee Stakes for New York-breds and Saratoga's Honorable Miss, which preceded her Ballerina victory—for

her new connections.

As commercial breeders, the Beadnells sell the babies as weanlings, yearlings, or 2-year-olds. They rely on their longtime friends, Joe and Anne McMahon and their son, Mike McMahon of McMahon & Hill Bloodstock in Kentucky, to consign their horses to sales and to aid them in purchasing mares. It was Mike McMahon who recommended to the Beadnells the private purchase of the stakes-placed Vindication mare, Miss Bodine, and the subsequent mating to Uncle Mo, which resulted in their record-setting sale of Mo Diddley.

"We are not racers; we are breeders," Susan Beadnell said. "I'm the one who pays the bills, and I tell Andy, 'We can't afford to be a racer.' As breeders, we enjoy seeing a horse we bred be so successful, like Haveyougoneaway. It's been surprising the attention we've got from being her breeders. Yesterday, in the mail, I got a really nice pewter cup engraved as being "The Breeder of the Month" from WinStar Farm, who stands her sire, Congrats. It was just so nice to receive that."

But the true reward of being the breeder of Haveyougoneaway is something else entirely.

"The breeders' award checks are very important to us because being a small

breeder means your chances of getting a horse like Haveyougoneaway are so small," she said. "We have friends who are also small breeders, and when they get checks for even, \$1,000 or \$2,000, it really makes a big difference."

One Wise Cowgirl is among 10 mares the Beadnells currently own. In the hope that lightning strikes twice, One Wise Cowgirl was bred to Congrats this year. The other 2016 covering stallions for the Beadnell mares include several New York sires, among them, Central Banker, Freud, Mission Impazible, and Teuflesberg,

"The New York-breds sired by New York stallions are a full 30% (breeder award), which really makes a lot of sense for a breeder," Andy Beadnell said. "But the Kentucky sires seems to draw a lot more interest at the sales, yet I really believe we have a couple of new sires in New York that are going to make a change of that, and one of them is Central Banker, who is standing at the Mc-Mahons. I have two babies by him this year—they are as nice as anything we have ever had on the ground."

Andy Beadnell pointed to Haveyougoneaway, and the multitude of other New York-breds that have proved competitive in open company stakes, as well as New York-breds sell for top dollar at auctions, as the ultimate poster horses for the Empire State's breeding program.

"Our story goes to show that you don't have to be from Kentucky to make money as breeders," he said. "It's a very, very good deal to breed horses in New York."

# Still Counting

Fourstar Crook wins sixth straight; Kharafa takes Cole for the third time



**HOT ON THE HEELS** of winning Saratoga's Yaddo Stakes in her stakes debut Aug. 26, Fourstar Crook quickly added another with a dominating  $2\frac{1}{4}$ length victory over The Tea Cups in Belmont's John Hettinger Stakes Sept. 25. The 4-year-old filly by Freud has now won six consecutive starts dating back to Oct. 8, 2015, when she broke her maiden over the same turf course at  $1\frac{1}{16}$  miles.

The 6-5 favorite in the Hettinger, Fourstar Crook sat back in seventh early under Javier Castellano and came with a wide move in the lane to take command inside the eighth pole. She got the nine furlongs in 1:49.27.

Bred by Kathleen M. Feron, Fourstar Crook races for Michael Dubb, Bethlehem Stables, and Gary Aisquith. She is trained by Chad Brown.

Out of the D'Accord mare Avril a Portugal (bred by the late John Hettinger), Fourstar Crook was foaled at Akindale Farm near Pawling. She is a graduate of the Fasig-Tipton New York-bred preferred yearling sale where she was purchased for \$55,000 by Allied Bloodstock. She next changed hands for

\$110,000 at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic spring sale of 2-year-olds after failing to meet her reserve for \$70,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Florida sale in March 2014.

"When the horse was first sent to us as a 2-year-old, she was kind of a small, immature-looking horse who trained OK," Brown said. "She got to the races a little bit, and then we kicked her out. Thankfully, Mike and all his partners were so patient. We just let the filly grow and develop over time, and, man, did she fill out! She looks nothing like she did when she was younger. It's nice to see a horse develop this way."

The previous day's Ashley T. Cole Stakes, worth \$125,000, went to veteran Kharafa, who became a millionaire while taking the Cole for the third time. Paul Braverman and Timothy Pinch's 7-year-old came to the Cole off two seconds, having been beaten a neck by Blacktype in Monmouth Park's Oceanport Stakes (gr. IIIT) on Haskell Day and a nose by King Kreesa in the West Point Stakes Aug. 26. Blacktype was also a winner Sept. 24, taking the Commonwealth Turf Cup Stakes (gr. IIT) at Laurel Park.

Kharafa was bred by Lawrence Durocher Jr. who campaigned the gelding for the first part of his racing career. After Durocher passed away in 2013, Kharafa won the Ashley T. Cole for the first time for Durocher's estate and was then sold by Durocher's daughter Kate to Braverman, a Boston investment manager.

Foaled at Mill Creek Farm near Stillwater, Kharafa is from the first North American crop of Kitalpha, a full brother to Kingmambo. He is out of the Kentucky-bred King of Kings mare Exquisite Cassie, a half sister to multiple stakes-winning New York-bred Lovely Amanda.

Trainer Tim Hills said, "I wish all horses could be as consistent as he is. He gets good this time of the year; it's like clockwork. He has two breezes before each race, and he shows up ready to run. Ultra-consistent. If all goes well, we'll look at the Mohawk Stakes (Oct. 22 at Belmont).


