Musings: A Tale of Two New York-breds

WITH the marquee Saratoga Showcase Day/Travers Day (gr. I) races in the immediate rear view, and with the marathon Keeneland September yearling sale on the horizon, my thoughts keep returning to two horses that distinguished themselves on that important racing weekend. They are a study in contrasts.

> Arguably, the two top New York-bred performances over Showcase/Travers weekend were delivered by Syndergaard, who annihilated his competition in the \$190,000 Funny Cide Stakes to kick off the all-New York-bred card Aug. 26, and Haveyougoneaway, who achieved a signature victory in the \$500,000 Ballerina Stakes (gr. I) the following day and is now on her way to the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (gr. I).

> The antecedents of these horses, except for the common thread of being New York-breds, could not be more different.

> On one end of the scale is Syndergaard, who commanded the top New York-bred selling price at this year's Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s spring sale when he was purchased for \$450,000. The colt previously sold for \$92,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July yearling sale. Now a perfect two-for-two and a stakes winner, Syndergaard has earned \$163,800 from his two races at Saratoga, along with corresponding breeder's awards. He appears to have unlimited potential.

> On the other end of the scale is newly minted grade I winner Haveyougoneaway. Having sold as a \$50,000 weanling at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November sale in 2011 and bringing \$105,000 as a yearling at the Fasig-Tipton New York-bred preferred yearling sale (so far, so good!), she ended up on offer at the 2013 Keeneland November sale, where Champion Racing Stable purchased her as a "racing or broodmare prospect" for just \$1,200. She, too, has unlimited potential.

> Syndergaard's and Haveyougoneaway's respective price tags at auction of \$450,000 and \$1,200 accent the polarization that exists these days across the board at Thoroughbred auctions. Moreover, this year at the

yearling sales we are also seeing declines in the major indicators.

The reasons for both phenomena are manifold, including a paucity of prospective owners, increased competition for the "right" horses, and challenges that pinhookers encountered in the 2-year-old market, which has led them to scale back on yearling purchases this year. On the other hand, the pair shows that first-rate New York-breds can come from just about anywhere—which is an undeniable tribute to the horses you are breeding. You need to keep on doing what you are doing. There is more on that below.

Here's another consideration. Haveyougoneaway began her career out of state. For her first owners she earned more than \$400,000, winning the Flashy Lady Stakes at Remington Park in September 2015 and, this year, nearly sweeping the filly and mare sprint series at Oaklawn Park with victories in the American Beauty and Spring Fever stakes and a second in the Carousel Stakes. It wasn't until she was privately purchased and relocated to New York that her talent began to generate breeder's awards and open owner's awards. After four starts in her native state, Haveyougoneaway has collected three stakes victories along with a second in another stakes race in New York and has earned nearly \$900,000 in all.

Our biggest asset for marketing New York-breds is their high-profile racetrack performances, but owners and prospective owners also need to know that New York-breds need to be competing in New York to reap full benefit of purses and program awards. This is the focus of much of New York Thoroughbred Breeders and Fund marketing, and you and your consignors need to be doing your utmost to spread the news as well. The savviest investors and trainers have known for a few years now that purses, racing opportunities, and the New York-bred stakes program mean that buying a New York-bred and racing in New York is a win-win proposition. We don't miss an opportunity to drive the message home, and you shouldn't either. Make no mistake, every weekend on the racetrack, rain or shine, the horses you breed will continue to support our cause.

Bred by Andy and Susan Beadnell, foaled at Bead Land & Cattle Company near Pottersville, and raced earlier in her career by Champion Racing Stable, Haveyougoneaway was purchased privately this vear by Sequel Racing and has three stakes victories and a second from four starts in New York. She had a second in the Critical Eve Stakes at Belmont Park May 30, a win in the July 3 Dancin Renee Stakes, and her first Saratoga graded win in the Honorable Miss. Owner Gary Barber joined the team prior to her score in the Ballerina.

Haveyougoneaway is by Congrats out of One Wise Cowgirl, an unraced New Yorkbred daughter of Wiseman's Ferry also bred by the Beadnells. One Wise Cowgirl has a weanling colt by Central Banker and has been bred back to Congrats.

Jon Clay's Alpha Delta Stables' Ancient Secret (Kantharos-Privacy, by Notebook) got the ball rolling for New York-breds July 22 in the Lake George Stakes (gr. IIT).

Bred by Lambholm and foaled at Cedar Ridge Farm near Pine Plains, the 3-year-old filly was a \$225,000 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s spring sale buy in 2015 by bloodstock agent Steven Young.

Privacy delivered an Afleet Alex colt March 16 and was covered by Lookin At Lucky for 2017.

J Stables, M. Scott Summers, and Hope Summers' Mind Your Biscuits won the Spa's Amsterdam Stakes (gr. II) July 30, giving trainer Robert Falcone Jr. his first stakes win and just the 19th career win for the 22-year-old conditioner.

Medaglia d'Oro Colt Brings \$300K at FT Saratoga

A colt by Medaglia d'Oro emerged as the top-selling New York-bred during the Aug. 9 second session of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale, selling for \$300,000 to Hartley/de Renzo. A New York-bred by Scat Daddy was the top Empire State-bred filly of the sale, selling earlier on the evening for \$250,000.

The Medaglia d'Oro yearling was bred by Gallagher's Stud and consigned by Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud, acting as Gallagher Stud's agent. The colt's dam Wild Chant was purchased by Gallagher's Stud at the 2011 Keeneland November sale for \$300,000. Out of Fun House, Wild Chant is a War Chant half sister to champion Untapable, winner of the 2014 Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (gr. I), and to grade I winner Paddy O'Prado.

The top New York-bred filly was bred by Avanti Stable and consigned by Paramount



The Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling sale experienced a 9.4% drop in average

Sales. An April baby foaled at Stonebridge Farm near Gansevoort, she is the third foal out of the winning Speightstown mare Speightful Lady.

Of the seven New York-breds offered at the Saratoga sale, four changed hands for an average of \$222,500.

Overall, the year-to-year average of the Saratoga sale dropped 9.4% to \$292,115. The median declined 5% over the two sessions to \$237,500, and the cumulative buy-back rate came in at 23.2%, up from 15.2% a year ago.

UNCLE MO FILLY SOARS AT OBS AUGUST

Offspring by last year's leading juvenile and first-crop sire Uncle Mo are certainly in demand these days based on his 19 stakes winners and his \$450,000 New York-bred colt selling at the Fasig-Tipton New York preferred sale of yearlings (see page 24). A New York-bred filly by the son of Indian Charlie went for \$150,000 Aug. 23 to top state-breds during the select session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s August yearling sale.

Hip 227, bred by Lansdowne Thoroughbreds and foaled at Sara-

toga Glen Farm near Schuylerville, was previously purchased by Hal Hatch for \$70,000 as a weanling at last fall's Keeneland November sale. Consigned by Imagine at OBS, she went to Moneyballs Racing & Sales.

The sale filly is the first foal out of Maryland-bred Dark Nebula, a multiple winner and earner of \$122,196.

Of 29 New York-breds to go through the ring in the select session, 21 yearlings sold for an average of \$23,962. The New York-bred median price was \$10,000. In the sale at large, the average price was \$40,667 (down 10% from \$45,163) while the median was \$25,000 (down 28.6% from \$35,000).

The select portion of the sale was followed by two open sessions that experienced downturns in all indices from 2015 figures.

For the entire three-day run, 97 New York-bred yearlings were offered with 72 reported as sold. The 25 unsold made for a 25.8% buyback rate, which was below the overall sale's mark of 46.2%.

The New York-bred average was \$11,832 with a median of \$4,750.

New York Thoroughbred Breeders presented its two annual scholarships in the winner's circle after the fourth race July 29 at Saratoga Race Course as part of the annual College & Alumni Day at the Spa.

Generously established by Joanne Nielsen to honor her late husband, Gerald A. Nielsen Sr., and by Vivien Malloy to honor her late daughter, Debby Malloy Winkler, the \$5,000 scholarships recognize a full-time student enrolled in an equine-related course of study at an accredited college or university in New York State. The awards are intended to foster the education and development of individuals who promise to make a positive contribution to the Thoroughbred industry in New York and beyond.

Receiving the 2015 Gerald A. Nielsen Sr. Scholarship was Cassandra Cromer. A graduate of Owen Valley Community High School in Spencer, Ind., before completing her undergraduate studies at Purdue University, Cromer just concluded her second year at the Cornell College of Veterinary Medicine.

An active member of the student chapter of the American Association of Equine Practitioners, Cromer is mainly interested in equine reproduction. In 2015 she successfully completed a Havemeyer Research Summer Fellowship at the Baker Institute of Health with a focus on mare reproductive care. After serving a post-graduate internship with a focus on Thoroughbreds, Cromer aspires to become a resident farm veterinarian, but would not rule out joining a large equine hospital.



Worth the Wait



While the buyers, consignors, and Fasig-Tipton staff might have hoped the Saratoga sale of New York-bred preferred yearlings would have started with a bang Aug. 13, they got a little more than they bargained for when the bang came first from the deafening thunder accompanying a storm that descended just as the sale was scheduled to begin and then from a tree felled by that storm landing on Barn 4.

Storm delays state-bred sale, figures wind up being consistent with national market

While neither humans nor equines were hurt, Fasig-Tipton executives made the call to postpone the first session of the two-night sale to the next day, running all 263 yearlings through the ring Aug. 14, the scheduled second night of the sale.

"The clinching blow was when it was raining so damn hard in the back walking ring that I couldn't hear, and rain was coming in sideways," said Boyd Browning, Fasig-Tipton's

I think we had more time, and we got more scopes on our horses this morning, so I think it mattered not at all. "

"We knew he was going to sell well," Beadnell said. "We didn't think he'd go quite that high. Joe reserved him higher than what I was kind of happy with, but it worked; he went way past his reserve. Joe knows his horses."

"Uncle Mo is maybe the most exciting new sire we've had in this sport in many, many years," said Cheyenne Stables' Everett Dobson. "I just liked (this colt's) presence, and he's a New York-bred. I like that; I race up here a lot.

"If they had had good weather last night, I think the prices would have been pretty much what they are today, but it was a great move on Fasig-Tipton's part to (postpone) the sale. It would have been brutal on everyone: buyers, sellers, the horses."

James J. Crupi signed more than a dozen tickets for himself and a handful of clients, including Hip No. 509 for \$235,000, a Gemologist colt out of the Stormy Atlantic mare Red Menace, consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency.

"The market was great," said Crupi, who purchased six horses on behalf of St Elias, including this one in partnership with Bob Peterson Racing.

of Flaunted, by Tale of the Cat, brought the secondhighest price of the sale, going to trainer Linda Rice for owner Sheila Rosenblum for \$375,000.

"There was a lot of interest," said Parrish of his overall consignment. "We probably did more shows on Saturday than we ever have. There were some very strong points, and luckily we had two of them."

Although at first concerned about the postponement, Parrish thought he ended up picking up some more bidders on the City Zip colt that sparked spirited bidding.

"I didn't talk to a consignor or buyer that thought (the postponement) had a significant impact," said Browning. "Some loved it. They thought it was easier to get commerce done. You don't want to go against live racing at Saratoga, but you do what you got to do."

One unintended result of the postponement was a significant update on Hip No. 447, whose sire Dialed In got his first graded stakes winner that after-

noon when Gunnevera won the Saratoga Special Stakes (gr. II) shortly before the colt out of May Who (by Lion Heart) went through the ring. He sold for \$260,000, the fifth-highest-priced colt in the sale, to Saratoga 7 Racing, a new partnership making its first purchases and who bought three horses.

"It helped the price go up," said Peter Edwards, who with Doug Cauthen picked out the horse. "We had to go higher than we thought, and more than we wanted to, but that's OK. His body's awesome, and we're just so happy to get him."

Saratoga 7's managing partner is Tony Malatino, owner of Sugar Plum Farm near Saratoga. With Diamond M Stable, he campaigned the multiple graded stakes-winning War Dancer, whose earnings are just shy of a million dollars. Malatino expects to stand War Dancer in New York next year.

Jeff Cannizzo, executive director of New York Thorough-

bred Breeders, thought the market in the sale overall was consistent with recent years. Acknowledging that the average and median were down slightly, he pointed out the strength at the higher end of the market and observed that the statebred program in New York offers breeders options beyond the sales ring.

"The horses that may not be in the upper echelon have the opportunity to race for \$44 million in purses," he said. "It gives New York-bred horses added value.

"The good horses are continuing to sell, so we'll continue to improve the quality of New York-bred horses and stress that quality," he continued. "All the indicators displayed that the upper part of the market is very strong for select New Yorkbred horses. A lot of people stated that from a pedigree standpoint, this is the highest-quality catalog ever."

Favorite Finishes

Hit It Once More, Super Surprise—both odds-on—win rich Showcase races

IT TOOK HIT IT ONCE MORE a while to find his way to the winner's circle, but after breaking his maiden in his sixth start by 4½ lengths, the 3-year-old has won three of his last four starts, all of them in impressive fashion.

The bay son of Hard Spun followed his dominant 6¹/₂-length victory in the \$164,150 New York Derby at Finger Lakes Gaming and Racetrack July 23 with an equally eye-catching win in the \$250,000 Albany Stakes on New York-bred Showcase Day at Saratoga Race Course Aug. 26.

Sent to the lead by jockey Kendrick Carmouche, Hit It Once More cruised through soft fractions while remaining out of reach of his six pursuers on a track rated "good." The odds-on favorite opened up turning for home, stretching his lead to 3¼ lengths and running the nine furlongs in 1:50.38.

With the win, the \$90,000 purchase has earned \$355,202 in 10 races, an accomplishment no doubt appreciated by owner Bill Parcells, whose August Dawn Farm purchased the horse at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic sale of 2-year-olds in training in May 2015.

"(Trainer) Gary (Sciacca) picked him and went over budget," said the former NFL coach. "When the horse was in the sale ring, he kept telling me we had 'to hit it once more, hit it once more.' Once we got him, I said 'That's his name.'"

Out of the Sunday Break mare Sunday Geisha, Hit It Once More was bred by Dennis Narlinger's JMJ Racing Stables.

Improving with distance, Hit It Once More was under consideration for the Travers Stakes (gr. I), run the day after the Albany, but Sciacca elected to keep the colt in state-bred company.

"Let them bang heads," said Sciacca.

"He was doing real well and he's a New York-bred, so we might as well take advantage of that. There's a lot of money in (New York-bred races)."

The owner of about a half-dozen New York-breds, Parcells purchased a \$290,000 colt by The Factor at last month's Fasig-Tipton sale of preferred New York-bred yearlings in Saratoga Springs.

"I just like (New York-breds)," said Parcells. "I'm from New York, and I look forward to (running more of them)."

Hit It Once More might take a shot against open company in his next start, with Parcells and Sciacca mulling a start in the Sept. 24 Pennsylvania Derby (gr. II) at Parx.

Super Effort

While Hit It Once More's front-running performance left little doubt with regard to his victory, Super Surprise's off-the-pace win in the \$200,000 Fleet

Indian Stakes left the outcome in doubt until the field was inside the eighth pole.

Racing several lengths off the pacesetting Roman Ceres, jockey John Velazquez began urging the 3-year-old Giant Surprise filly heading into the turn. Though she didn't appear to respond with alacrity, she began to kick coming into the stretch, only to find herself without running room.

Switched to the outside, Super Surprise took off, at first with encouragement from Velazquez, then pulled away to win by four lengths. Racing for the first time beyond a mile, the dark bay or brown filly ran the 1¹/₈ miles in 1:51.67 for her third straight win and second off a lengthy layoff.

"I wasn't really concerned," said owner Mike Repole, "but when Johnny started to push her, (trainer) Todd (Pletcher) got worried. Then all of a sudden she kind of took off."

Repole purchased the filly out of the Langfuhr mare Miz Lynne Kelly for \$55,000 in 2014 at the Fasig-Tipton sale of preferred New York-bred yearlings. She was bred by Allen C. Hallett and is by Repole's stallion Giant Surprise, who was ranked sixth on last year's first-crop sire list and stands at

Showcase Day Trifecta for Sue Carlson

Sue Carlson, who owns the 190-acre Carlland Stables, raised three of the winners on Showcase Day Aug. 26 at Saratoga Race Course, creating her own trifecta.

Raised on the farm, near Avon, N.Y., in the western Genesee Valley were Gerald and Susan Kresa's King Kreesa, winner of the \$150,000 West Point Stakes (see page 34); Belwood Stables-bred Cause I'm Alex, a 5-yearold gelding by Afleet Alex—Giant Leap, by Giant's Causeway who won a \$75,000 allowance optional claiming race for Jeffrey Englehart and Frank Fiumera; and Sagamore Farm's Come Around, a 4-year-old Midshipman— Joined Forces, by Dixie Union gelding bred by Stephen Jacobs who won the finale, a \$73,000 maiden special weight at nine furlongs.

Rockridge Stud near Hudson. With three wins and five top-three finishes in six races, Super Surprise has earned \$369,800.

Because of what Repole said was an ankle issue, the filly was given the winter off after she won the \$250,000 Maid of the Mist Stakes last October on New York-bred Showcase Day at Belmont.



Though confident of Super Surprise's ability to win in open company races, Repole also pragmatically takes advantage of the New York-bred program, with the Fleet Indian being the target for the filly's summer campaign. For the fall, he's looking at New York's Stallion Series and New York-bred stakes races, but he's also considering a start in the \$1 million Cotillion Stakes (gr. I) at Parx on Sept. 24.

"She's gone from six furlongs to a mile and an eighth off a layoff," he pointed out. "She's had two Beyer Speed Figures in the 80s. I think she's more than a New York-bred filly."

"My guess is that they'll have a small field with Songbird and Cathryn Sophia (expected to run)," he continued, referring to the Cotillion. "I'm not saying that we're going there and beat Songbird, but second or third would be nice."

Fast Ball

Syndergaard, named for the New York Mets pitcher, aces the Funny Cide; Iron Mizz scores in Seeking the Ante

AN INTRIGUING EDITION of the \$190,000 Funny Cide Stakes for 2-year-old New York-breds kicked off the Showcase Day festivities Aug. 26 at Saratoga Race Course and featured a matchup between two highly regarded maiden winners, Bobby On Fleek and Syndergaard, each of whom had dazzled in their career debuts.

Syndergaard, however, a son of Majesticperfection out of the Gold Case mare Magic Belle, proved to be superior on this day and ran his three rivals off their feet on his way to a 10¹/₄-length victory in the 6¹/₂-furlong dirt race, which was run over a muddy and sealed track. The front-runner, who was ridden by John Velazquez, set

scorching factions—:21.52 and :44.35 en route to a final time of 1:16.75.

Bobby On Fleek finished second, three lengths in front of Gold for the King, who was 11¼ lengths ahead of Tribecca.

Syndergaard, named for New York Mets pitching wizard Noah Snydergaard, is trained by Todd Pletcher. The partnership that owns him is headed by Eric Fein, who stood former New York stallion Musket Man, the third-place finisher in both the 2009 Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (gr. I) and the BlackBerry Preakness Stakes (gr. I). Also owning a percentage of the Funny Cide winner is Fein's son, Harris; son-inlaw, Guri Singh; Singh's brother-in-law, Jerry Walia; and Fein's business partner, Christopher McKenna.

Fein purchased Syndergaard, who was bred by Burleson Farms, as a 2-year-old at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s spring auction. Acting as agent was Ian Brennan, who signed the \$450,000 ticket on behalf of Fein, who operates a title insurance company in Long Island, N.Y.

"I got sick for a year so I wasn't around a lot, and my children did a lot of things for me," Fein explained in the winner's circle. "I gave them all a little bit of (interest in) a couple of horses. It's very emotional for me because I had a tough time and now all my children have as big as an interest as I do."

The leggy chestnut, the sixth-most expensive colt at the OBS sale and the co-bullet holder at the breeze show, was sent to Brennan's Ocala, Fla. farm for one month after he was bought.

"From the sale, to Ian, to Todd, he looked like a different horse," Fein remarked. "Ian was able to get at least 150 to 200 pounds on him that month—he looked like Hercules."

While Brennan was putting weight on the colt, Fein was playing the name game.

"We did a thing in my office where people come up with names and if we pick one and we can get it (from The Jockey Club), that person gets \$250," Fein said.

"The Mets had such a crazy pitch-





ing staff before the season started," he added, "and players started to get hurt. (The name) deGrom was taken...Matz wouldn't sound like a good name, nor would Harvey. Syndergaard is just a great name."

Fein and Pletcher believe the time has come to step up to the plate and point for an open company race with Syndergaard, who may run next in the Champagne Stakes (gr. I) at Belmont Park Oct. 8.

Syndergaard's first stakes win was not the only cause for celebration: Fein said doctors gave him the "all-clear" on what was considered a serious illness, just days before the Funny Cide was run.

"Now that I'm finally healthy again, we are going to do a lot of spending this year," Fein said with a wide grin. Iron Mizz ups the Ante on Showcase day; at left, breeder/owners Barry and Sheryl Schwartz

Iron Ante

Iron Mizz, a 2-year-old Mizzen Mast filly owned and bred by Barry K. Schwartz' Stonewall Farm, won the \$200,000 Seeking the Ante Stakes later in the card.

Iron Mizz, a maiden winner on turf, was making her dirt debut. The Seeking the Ante winner was produced by Iron Goddess, a New York-bred daughter of More Than Ready. Schwartz purchased Iron Goddess for \$250,000 out of the 2004 Keeneland September yearling sale, and raced her before she joined his broodmare band.

"The day I bought (Iron Goddess) in the sale, Todd Pletcher came up to me after and said, 'She was the prettiest horse in the sale today,' " Schwartz recalled.

Pletcher, who trained More Than Ready, received the chance to reacquaint himself with the family, when Schwartz gave him Iron Goddess' sixth foal, Iron Mizz, to train.

Iron Mizz, who broke her maiden against New York-breds going six furlongs July 3, is Iron Goddess' first stakes winner. Since producing Iron Mizz, she has foaled an English Channel filly and an Exchange Rate colt. Iron Goddess, a stakes winner on the turf, is currently in foal to Tale of the Cat.






Kings and Stars

King Kreesa, Fourstar Crook make their presence known on the Saratoga turf **AT AGE 7** with 30-plus starts under his belt, King Kreesa might not seem like the best candidate to run in two Saratoga stakes races within six days, but the horse that has finished on the board in almost two-thirds of his races once again showed his mettle by doing exactly that, winning the Aug. 26 West Point Stakes at Saratoga Race Course.

Gerald and Susan Kresa's homebred dark bay or brown gelding was fourth in

the one-mile Fourstardave Stakes (gr. IT) on Aug. 20, and trainer David Donk elected to make the quick turnaround after seeing how well King Kreesa had come out of the race. Sent to the lead in the 11/16-mile West Point by jockey José Ortiz, the son of King Cugat was able to get away with soft early fractions but nonetheless had to hold off late charges by three of his opponents, including Kharafa, another veteran of the perennially competitive New York-bred older male turf division. King

Kreesa gutted out a nose decison to win the race for the second time in three years, after finishing second last year to regular rival Lubash, who was scratched from the 2016 edition. King Kreesa got the trip over a yielding inner turf course in 1:42.96.

"We are so happy," said Susan Kresa in the winner's circle, a huge grin on her face.

"He came out of the (Fourstardave) so strong, so we figured why not go for it?" said her husband. "David obviously made the right decision."

Out of the Storm Creek mare Storm's Advance and bred by the Kresas' Horse Partners, King Kreesa has earned \$1,371,704 in 34 races, with a slate of 11-7-4.

"It's fun to win them like that," said Gerald, admitting he wasn't sure that his horse had gotten to the wire first.

In six races this year King Kreesa has two wins and a runner-up finish, and the Kresas have no thoughts of retiring him any time soon.

"We'll give him at least one more year," said Gerald. "He'll get the winter off, and if he's willing to keep going, we're willing to go with him. When he gives a sign that he wants to quit, that's it."

The Kresas, who traveled from their Minnesota home for both Saratoga races, campaign three horses, all of them New York-breds, one of them is Lady Kreesa, a stakes-placed half sister to King Kreesa. Though they've been out of the breeding business, they'll get back into it when Lady Kreesa retires, to breed another generation of New York-breds.

"The program has been very good to us," said Susan.

FOURSTAR SELECTION

Debuting in stakes company and putting a four-race winning streak on the line, Fourstar Crook made it five in a row when she won the \$150,000 Yaddo Stakes for older fillies and mares, her first start on yielding turf.

Breaking from post 10, jockey

Javier Castellano guided the bay filly by Freud into the two-path, racing well back of a pacesetting Invading Humor. Under encouragement by Castellano, Fourstar Crook made steady progress in the stretch, advancing to win by three-quarters of a length, running the 1¹/₁₆ miles in 1:43.56.

Selected by Gary Young, Fourstar Crook was purchased at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic sale of 2-year-olds in May 2014 for \$110,000 by Michael Dubb, who is joined in ownership by Michael Caruso's ly raced filly's starts are generally spaced out more than the 19 days they were in August, but as Dubb pointed out, "This is Saratoga. If you're going to (take a shot), this is the place."

The Yaddo was Fourstar Crook's third start off a seven-month layoff that was, said Brown, due not to an injury but to the decision to give her time off ahead of a 4-year-old campaign.

"She's a New York-bred grass horse; there was no reason to race her down in

ON A RECENT AFTERNOON in Christophe Clement's Belmont Park barn, the horses were tucked-up in their stalls, awaiting their evening meal. The most discernible sound was the swoosh of oats deposited by the trainer into the meticulously placed feed tubs lined up outside the stalls.

As Clement methodically worked his way down the shed row of Barn 21, feed scoop in hand, he began pointing out the New York-breds in his stable to a visitor.

"New York's program has been very good to me; I've had a lot of nice horses," Clement remarked as he paused in front of the stall of Governor Malibu, the fourthplace finisher in this year's \$1.5 million Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (gr. I) for Jump Sucker Stable and Oak Bluff Stables.

When Clement completed his feeding duties, he left the barn to saddle several runners on Belmont Park's twilight card. The sole win that evening came from a New York-bred, Lulu's Blues, a daughter of former Empire State leading sire Bluegrass Cat. The 3-year-old filly won a restricted maiden claiming race for her breeder and owner, Patricia A. Generazio.

Generazio is also the owner and breeder of the Clement-trained Too Discreet, a full sibling to Discreet Marq. Both are New York-breds, and each provided Generazio and Clement with stakes wins in open company. Too Discreet, a 3-year-old son of

Discreet Cat out of the Marquetry mare To Marquet, is still racing, while retired grade I winner and millionaire Discreet Marq, now owned by Moyglare Stud

Farm which purchased the mare at auction for \$2.4 million in 2014, is in Ireland and in foal to Galileo. After the purchase, Moyglare Stud, longtime clients of Clement, continued to race her in New York until her retirement last year.

Another Clement-trained poster horse for New York's state-bred program is Leonard Pivnick homebred Lubash. The 9-year-old son of New York sire Freud has earned more than \$1.3 million and is a two-time graded stakes winner.

Clement, who has been training in New York since the early 1990s after his arrival from his native France, estimates his 80-horse stable comprises "10-15%" New York-breds.

The benefits of having a New Yorkbred that can hold its own in open company is obvious, but Clement said his

stable's ability to compete in the races restricted to New York-breds also plays a vital role in his operation.

"When you train in New York and you open the condition book, most days you have two or three races that are for New York-breds only," Clement said. "If you have a choice of 10 races, and two or three of them are for New York-breds, and you don't compete in the state-bred races, you're basically writing yourself out of a quarter or a third of the races every day."

But it's not just about the prevalence of New York-bred offerings in the condition book that has Clement keen on the New York-bred program. He also sees it as a tremendous opportunity for owners, particularly those new to the business, to get involved in a program that features lucrative purses for both its overnight and stakes races and that is further buoyed by award money for owners and breeders.

"I think it makes a lot of sense to guide some of the owners coming into the business to think about the New York-bred program because you just get a better return on your money," Clement said. "I always tell quite a few (sales) agents if they see a nice New York-bred for a certain amount of money to call me. If you're a trainer in New York, it's easier to go with a New York-bred when you're trying to get a client involved at a more reasonable price. It's a good way to become involved.

"For instance, (owner) Peter Deutsch has been really lucky and has owned New York-bred stakes winners Saratoga Dreamer, Adirondack Summer, and Summer Breezing," he continued. "Peter was new to the game when he came to me, and all those horses were bought for reasonable (prices), below one-hundred-thousand dollars."

When Clement launched his career

a quarter of a century ago, the program had a different look—it was the exception rather than the rule that found New York-breds competing successfully in open company.

"The program was nowhere as good as it is now. Most of the horses then couldn't compete in open company—very few," Clement said. "I think the program has improved tremendously.

"The money is probably the engine behind the improvement," he added. "With more money (for purses and bonus awards), people have been breeding better New York-breds and better stallions are standing in New York. And people are paying more attention to the female family."

Clement occasionally partners with others in breeding New York-breds. He currently co-owns a mare with Don Robinson of

> Winter Quarter Farm who is in foal to Lemon Drop Kid and will give birth next year at Doug Koch's Berkshire Stud near Pine Plains. Berkshire Stud is the birthplace of Governor Malibu, a son of Malibu Moon who is co-owned by his breeder, Richard Leahy of Oak Bluff Stables. Clement trained Governor Malibu's stakes-winning dam, Akilina, a daughter of Langfuhr bred and raced by Leahy, and raised and foaled at Berkshire Stud.

> "There is no doubt in my mind that New York can produce a good horse," Clement said. "It's obvious. If you actually go to these farms in New York—I've been lucky enough to train for Gallagher Stud and Berkshire—these are top-class farms. The grass looks great, the farms look great, and the horses look very good and healthy. There is no reason why you can't produce a top-class horse in New York. New York can compete with any other state."


